Bulk Waste Clean Up 2018

Moring Disposal will be providing the Bulky Waste Clean-Up Day for all homes in the City of Lanark.

Program Date: Saturday, April 28th, 2018 - All acceptable bulk waste should be set at the curb the night before or by 6:00 a.m. Items set out after the truck has passed will not be collected.

Waste Collection Limit: Each participating residence may set out up to two (2) large bulky items and one (1) cubic yard of miscellaneous waste (equal to approximately seven 32 gallon garbage containers).

Program Guidelines: Miscellaneous bulk waste should be contained in bags or boxes. Uncontained misc. items will not be collected. Large appliances, electronics, and construction material are prohibited. TO follow is a detailed list of acceptable and unacceptable items.

ACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS

Couches
Sectional - (limit (1) full sectional)
Sleeper sofas
Rocker/recliners
Coffee/end tables
Kitchen tables
Bed frames
Mattress/box springs
Baby beds (cribs)
Bicycles
Swing Sets (Broken down to max 4 ft. pieces)
Dressers, shelving, cabinets, etc.
Push mowers (Fuel & oil must be drained)

ACCEPTABLE MISC. ITEMS

Boxes or cans of small items including: Tricycles, outdoor toys, lawn tools, grills, lawn chairs, baby swings, playpens, walkers, car seats, lawn tools, grills, lawn chairs, baby swings, playpens, walkers, car seats, fans, dishes, clothing, pillows, picture frames, area rugs, etc.

UNACCEPTABLE

Air conditioners
De-humidifiers
Water heater/softener
Windows
Plate glass
Riding lawn mowers
Tires
Demolition/remodeling debris
Cement, rock, or brick
Carpeting
Car parts
Auto batteries
Liquid waste of any kind
Household hazardous waste
Medical waste
Solid steel posts
All heavy gauge steel
Yard waste
