# **WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE**

Dear Valued Lanark Water Customer,

The City of Lanark is starting a project to clean, repair, blast, and paint the 300,000-gallon elevated water tank. This is a routine maintenance project and is expected after 20 years of service life. Please be advised during this construction and painting, City of Lanark water storage capacity of the system will be extremely limited compared to normal operating conditions. In order to meet the needs and demand of all consumers, the City of Lanark is requesting water conservation by all water utility consumers within the community to ensure everyone has an adequate water supply for daily needs. While the construction and painting project is taking place, the City of Lanark is requesting no excessive water use by all consumers in the community. Examples of this are no hose running, no watering of lawns, no sprinkler use, and no swimming pool filling. The anticipated construction and conservation period is currently estimated from May 9, 2019 to July 25, 2019, however may be reduced or extended as construction and weather requires. Regular daily consumer use for laundry, showers, and drinking is acceptable but should be conservative as well so overall supply and demand is not an issue. Additionally, please report any potential water main breaks to Lanark officials asap for investigation and repair. The City of Lanark Public Works Department is doing everything possible to make sure the water quality and supply demands of the system are met during the construction and painting process.

Thank you in advance for your partnership and efforts to conserve water while the City of Lanark improves the water infrastructure.
